

COVID-19 Health & Safety Policies at AMRoC

Updated March 25, 2020

For the foreseeable future:

- > AMROC is open by appointment only through at least the end of April.
- Work group or meetings related to important operations are limited to a maximum of 10 people, unless or until otherwise recommended by the US CDC.
- All guests must sanitize their hands upon arrival.
- ➤ Group/meet up organizers must clean areas used after a meeting, including tables, chairs, tools, electronics or other equipment used, with sanitizing cleaners we'll supply.
- ➤ Visitors over the age of 60 or anyone with pre-existing health conditions is advised not to visit AMRoC, for their own health and safety.
- Anyone showing signs of illness is asked not to visit and will be asked to leave AMRoC if cold or flu symptoms are exhibited, for everyone else's health and safety.
- > Seating at tables and work benches is separated please keep it that way and do not rearrange seating.

What You Can Do

Ultimately, it is up to individuals to stay intelligently informed, practice safe hygiene and take precautions urged by the CDC and local health departments to prevent the spread of illnesses like the flu and COVID-19.

- > Greet with elbow and fist bumps, nods and bows, instead of handshakes and hugs
- > Sanitize your hands upon entering the Fab Lab and when leaving,
- Wash hands regularly as directed, while on site, and
- > Do Not visit if you're not feeling well.
