Small equipment, furnishings evaluation and repairs	Basic inspections and repairs with the help of staff for items such as laptops, computers, 3D printers, lamps, small appliances, etc. 3D printed replacement parts	-Soldering Stations -Various limited electrical components -Some cabling and wires -Some fasteners
Technical Assistance	Computer lab for completing FEMA and other paperwork Laptop loans Fabrication and prototyping needs for parts repairs or replacements	-Computers -3D printers -CNC -Laser Cutter
Drone Resources	Fly throughs and flyovers of homes and businesses with drones for surveillance of damage or other documentation needs	-Drones
Textiles/Sewing	Repairs to existing clothing and other fabric home goods such as curtains, bedding, pillows, basic chair bottom upholstery, etc. Also sewing classes to create new clothing	-Sewing machines -Serger -Full sewing center
Hand/Power Tools	Basic furniture and goods repair clinic.	-Hand drill -Hand saw -Jigsaw -Wood and other general glues -Screwdrivers -Allen wrenches -Some fasteners
