## Volunteer Opportunities at FCDI's AMRoC Fab Lab

AMRoC Fab Lab is a program of the nonprofit Foundation for Community Driven Innovation (FCDI) and dedicated to capacity building STEM, workforce, and entrepreneurship programs for all ages. Volunteers contributing at least 20 hours a month receive free access to AMRoC Fab Lab workshops and resources, including 3D printing and free participation in most classes or programs.

<b>Guest Services</b>	Answer questions, give tours, help people learn about and sign up for programs – low key, opportunity where you can do classwork in between guests. <i>For College &amp; High School volunteers: Good for any major.</i>	Tuesday-Friday (your pick of days) 2 shifts available: 12 pm to 3:30 pm 3:30 pm to 7: 00 pm or all day
<b>Childcare/programming support</b>	Providing educational childcare support for adults in our workforce and entrepreneurship programs – LEGOS, simple robotics, build or art projects – <i>For College &amp; High School volunteers: Great for Early Childhood/Elementary Education students, or others with early childhood work experience</i>	For entrepreneurship training program, which runs November – January, and occasionally other programs – custom schedule
<b>Youth Robotics Program Support</b>	Providing assistance during middle and high school robotics programs – great for those with interest or expertise in Electrical, Mechanical, Computer Science, and Engineering fields, as well as business and general youth mentoring experience	Saturdays 1 pm to 7 pm
<b>Shop Support</b>	Helping provide maintenance, organization and operational support in our workshop, 3D printing support – Great for those with mechanical, woodworking or related skills and interests	Fridays and Saturdays as well as set times during weekdays, at Volunteers' availability
<b>Media/Marketing</b>	Social Media and website support – <i>For College &amp; High School volunteers: Good for Media &amp; Marketing, Communications and related majors</i>	Custom schedule
<b>Entrepreneurship &amp; Small Business Support mentoring/coaching</b>	Providing educational guidance, mentoring and support to those in our Equity in Entrepreneurship program - <i>For College &amp; High School volunteers: Great for those with business and finance experience, professional development, media and marketing, and related</i>	Weeknights during EE programming (usually Fridays)
<b>Sewing and Textiles Support</b>	Volunteers with interests in sewing, costuming, textiles and related – <i>For College &amp; High School volunteers: Great for performing arts, fashion, textiles related majors</i>	Tuesdays, Wednesdays and/or Thursdays– 5 pm to 7:30 pm - sewing group sessions and special classes
